5.14 Minutes of the meeting of the Parish Council held on Thursday 13th April 2017

5.15 Matters Arising

- 3.13.1 There had been no work undertaken on the gate from Hackford to Embley.
- 4.10.2 It was reported that the County Council had sent letters to determine who was responsible for putting in the hardstanding at Dalton. This would need retrospective planning permission. Gill Whatmough was going to liaise with the County Council.
- 4.15.1 Juliet Rogers had signed the agreement regarding the grazing on the wetlands.
- 4.16.1 It was reported that the litter picking had been successful.

5.16 <u>Public Participation</u>

There were no members of the public present.

5.17 Correspondence

- 5.17.1 An email had been received from NALC advising that there were vacancies on the County Committee.
- 5.17.2 An email had been received regarding the first Northumberland Day being held on 28th May.
- 5.17.3 A request had been received from Northumberland Domestic Abuse Services a letter was to be sent advising to apply next financial year.

5.18 Website

Gill Whatmough advised there had been 285 sessions between 13th April and 10th May with 67% new and 33% returning.

5.19 Financial Report

Tynedale Community Bank was discussed as a possible bank account. Skipton Building Society was also an option. Greg Finch agreed to investigate.

5.20 Planning Applications.

Proposal for existing store to be demolished and the erection of a holiday let (use class C3)

The Parish Council had no objection to this application.

Allendale Common – Proposed works to Moorland tracks

It was agreed to reply advising that the Parish Council's original objections were still valid. It was agreed that various issues needed to be addressed such as movement of materials and responsibility for damage caused by vehicles. Concern was expressed that if the project was to go ahead it would encourage more off roaders onto the common. Assurance was to be requested that the bridlepath should not be upgraded to a BOAT. Gill Whatmough agreed to email a response.

5.21 <u>Smelting Arches</u>

It was reported that the Parish Council had received the final £150 from Friends of the North Pennines.

5.22 <u>Broadband</u>

- 5.22.1 It was reported that the agreement had been signed.
- 5.22.2 Paul Pickworth was liaising with Andrew Nixon regarding the digging of a trench for the electric cable.

5.23 Highways and Footpaths

- 5.23.1 A meeting has been arranged with Highways who has been given the plans of Hexhamshire indicating problem areas. It was reported that some roads are as much as 3 feet narrower due to lack of verge maintenance.
- 5.23.2 The bridge at the bottom of the Peth needs attention.
- 5.24 **BOATs**
- 5.24.1 There is still quite a lot of activity on the restricted BOATs.
- 5.25 Reports Wetlands
- 5.25.1 Willow classes are scheduled in the last week of May, June and July.
- 5.25.2 It may be possible to claim on the countryside stewardship scheme.

 The Rural Payment Agency should be contacted as a first step. Alastair Stevens was to investigate.

 School
- 5.25.3 The school is optimistic regarding pupil numbers for next year. $\frac{\text{Hall}}{\text{Hall}}$
- 5.25.4 The Spring Fayre made a total of £530. Thanks were given to Gill Whatmough.
- 5.25.5 Talks and the Christmas Fayre have been planned.
- 5.25.6 The new staging has been ordered at a total of £3600.

Sportsfield

- 5.25.7 The insurance is due for renewal. £559.56 per annum. It was agreed to tie in for 3 years for a fixed rate.
- 5.25.8 Hirers of the sportsfield are to show proof of their insurance.
- 5.25.9 It was reported that weeds are coming through the multisport facility and it needs spraying.

5.26 Any Other Business

- 5.26.1 Bins are being left on the roadside at St Helens Gate. Gill Whatmough was to request assistance from Two Castles regarding this matter.
