Hexhamshire Parish Council PLANNING PROCEDURE

- 1. Hexhamshire Parish Council (HPC) is a statutory consultee for full planning applications made within the Parish.
- 2. HPC may also comment on agricultural planning applications, including prior notifications and prior approvals.
- 3. Planning applications are considered by the whole Council at the monthly meetings.
- 4. HPC takes into account current planning policy, legislation and objections from third parties.
- Each application is considered on its merits, and we follow the guidelines issued by Northumberland County Council, which are communicated at their regular training sessions, which we attend.
- 6. An objection will only be made where there is considered to be a breach of material planning considerations.
- 7. Where appropriate, constructive comments regarding the design, siting and/or appearance of the proposals are made. Planning approval subject to conditions might also be suggested.
- The meetings are open to the public and all discussions are recorded in the minutes which are published on the <u>www.hexhamshire.org.uk</u> website, and summarised in the Hexhamshire magazine.
