10.8 Matters for Discussion with the Unitary Councillor

- 10.8.1 The local plan is out for consultation; it is hoped that results will be in by Christmas. The process has taken 2 years, compared with 8 years for the previous plan. It allows for small scale development in rural areas but has cut back on the overall number of houses to be provided.
- 10.8.2 CH has donated £8,000 from his community chest to the school for the purchase and construction of a yurt
- 10.8.3 Grass verges we should select three we wish to preserve; David Hunt from NCC will then assess them from a safety point of view
- 10.8.4 NCC have grand plans for the construction of new schools, including Ponteland, Hexham, Haydon Bridge and Berwick
